# DR. ALAN FRIEDLANDER

---

Over the past 40 years Dr. Alan Friedlander has spent 12,000 hours underwater—from coral reefs to the poles and to depths of thousands of meters. Alan recently retired as Chief Scientist for the National Geographic Society's Pristine Seas program and is currently a researcher at the Hawai'i Institute of Marine Biology at the University of Hawai'i.

His work on marine protected areas ranges from small locally community-managed areas to some of the largest protected areas on the planet.

# Fish assemblage structure: main & northwestern Hawaiian Is





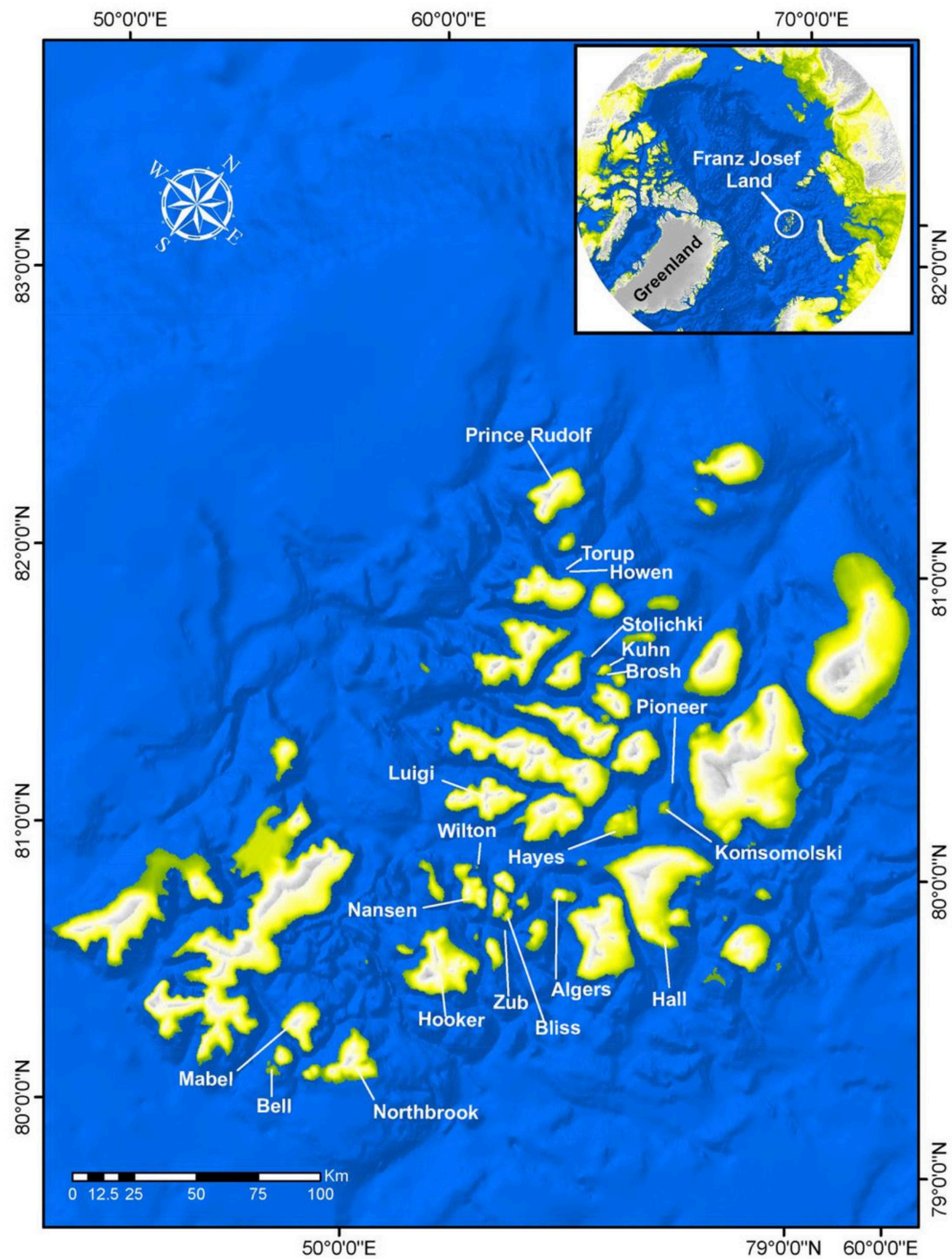

## EMERGENCY ACTION PLANS

- **Do you currently have an EAP for your pod?**
- **Things to consider:**
  - The ocean is very beautiful but can also be very dangerous.
  - Be prepared for the worst so you can have the best outcome!
- **How to prepare**
  - **Check the conditions**
  - Implement a buddy system before you swim
  - Don't leave anyone behind
  - Know where the nearest lifeguard stations are, if there are none, what about the nearest hospitals or medical facilities
  - Learn the signals for HELP, I'm Okay, Shark Nearby
- **Additional things you can do**
  - Encourage your pod to take a CPR class
  - Have a first aid kit available
  - Have a plan of action
    - If someone gets lost... who swims to shore, who stays to search, who calls 911, who checks the beach and nearby areas out of the water ie the person's car, what is the meeting point
    - If someone gets hurt in the water... who can assist in towing, who can swim nearby to find a vessel or lifeguard
    - Where are the nearest exit points
